Notary Public services are provided by John Mark Lello.

SERVICES

The service provided by me is that of a Notary Public carrying out all permitted notarial activities, e.g. provision of certified copies of documents such as passports, academic certificates; attestation of execution of documents for use overseas, e.g. powers of attorney, land sale and purchase documents, medical registrations; including, where appropriate and if required, arranging legalisation of documents via a third party agent and sending them to their final destination.

Foreign & Commonwealth Office legalisation ('Apostille') normally takes 3 – 4 working days.
Consular legalisation times vary from a few days to several weeks.

Please note

It is not my responsibility to check the contents of documents, other than where foreign lawyers/agents have specifically instructed that I insert personal details.

You must satisfy yourself as to the contents of the documentation, including any personal details, before signing. If there are any errors or you have any concerns, you should raise them with your contacts overseas prior to signing.

HOW TO MAKE A COMPLAINT

If you are dissatisfied about the service, you have received please do not hesitate to contact me. If we are unable to resolve the matter you may then complain to the Notaries Society of which I am a member, who have a Complaints Procedure which is approved by the Faculty Office.

This procedure is free to use and is designed to provide a quick resolution to any dispute.

If you have any difficulty in making a complaint in writing, please do not hesitate to call the Notaries Society or the Faculty Office for assistance.

Even if you have your complaint considered under the Notaries Society Approved Complaints Procedure, you may at the end of that procedure, or after a period of eight weeks from the date you first notified me that you were dissatisfied, make your complaint to the Legal Ombudsman, if you are not happy with the result.

- **FCO Apostille Standard:** £20 for 1 document; £40 for 2; £60 for 3 - 10
- **FCO Apostille Premium:** £30.00 for 1 document; £60 for 2; £90.00 for 3 - 10
- **FCO Apostille Standard & Consulate:** £50.00 per document / £100.00 capped up to 10 documents
- **FCO Apostille Premium & Consulate:** £60.00 per document / £120.00 capped up to 10 documents
- **Consulate only:** £30.00 for 1 document; £60 for 2; £90.00 for 3 - 10
- **China supplement:** £100

Disbursements

- **FCO fee per Apostille: £30.00 Standard / £75.00 Premium**
- **Consular fees vary – price on application**

Legalisation only

Where no notarisation is required, we make an administrative charge of £30 for obtaining FCO/Consular legalisation through H&S Notary practice.

H&S service fees and disbursements as shown above will also apply.

China supplement

Where legalisation by the Chinese embassy is required, we charge an additional £20 to reflect the extra work involved.
